

The Selection Process

- Publicity for seeking applications was done through community organizations & their magazines, posters in community hostels, MVPM website etc.
- Applications were invited from final year/ passed students of BE/B. Tech, ME/M.Tech, MCA, MBBS, MD/MS, MBA in a specified format. Last date for receiving applications at MVPM office was 31st July 2012
- Applications were scrutinized by MVPM Scholar Committee to ensure that all applications meet specified eligibility norms.
- Application summary was forwarded to a panel of jury.
- Jury panel met at MVPM office on 30th September 2012 and discussed, debated & decided following criteria for selection.
 - 1. Academics performance, up to graduation.
 - 2. Academic performance at graduation/higher level
 - 3. Professional contribution, besides academics
 - 4. Extra curricular performance with academic value
- Panel of jury recommended five names for MVPM Scholar award from among all eligible applicants.
- MVPM Scholar 2012' awards were presented on 19th January 2013.

Each awardee has been presented a cash award of Rs 50,000 and a citation at the hands of Chief Guest Padma Bhushan Dr. S. B. Mujumdar, Chancellor, Symbiosis International University and Guest of Honour, Shri Sureshji Kakani, Joint Secretary, Urban Development,

Government of Maharashtra.

- Dr. S.B.Mujumdar is a distinguished Academician and Educationist. He is the Founder & President of Symbiosis a multi-lingual, multi-national and multi-disciplinary educational complex of international repute. Symbiosis comprises 43 institutes with over 27,000 students who hail from all states of India and from 80 different countries. The ministry of HRD, Govt. of India conferred the 'Deemed to be University' status on 27 institutions of Symbiosis which are now under the ambit of Symbiosis International University of which Dr Mujumdar is the Chancellor. In appreciation of his long illustrious career, the President of India awarded the prestigious 'Padma Bhushan' to Dr. S.B.Mujumdar in 2012. He is recipient of several other prestigious awards such as 'Punyabhushan' award , 'FIE Foundation Award' and 'Maharashtra Gaurav Award'. Dr. Mujumdar was also the Chairman of the education wing of FICCI. He was also a member of the Executive Council of the University of Pune.
- Shri Sureshji Kakani, is an IAS officer currently holding the position of Joint Secretary, Urban Development in Government of Maharashtra. He holds a Master's degree in Agricultural Technology with specialization in Food Sciences. He also holds MA in Asian Studies from University of California, Berkley, USA. In his 25 years of civil services career he has performed important roles such as Deputy Secretary, Additional Collector of Mumbai, Officer on Special Duty etc. He has also worked on an assignment with World Bank.
