

Dr. Brajesh Maheshwari stepped in and started teaching Physics with dedication, despite having a strong grasp of Mathematics.

In 1993, the Rajasthan PET examination was held, and the second and third ranks were secured by students from Kota, which further increased students' faith in ALLEN. Determined to make subjects like Physics easier for his students, Dr. Brajesh Maheshwari created short notes and tricks. His students started topping exams every year, and the fragrance of his teaching soon spread all over the country, with students from all over India pouring into Kota to study. Dr. Brajesh Maheshwari's journey from a blackboard to a digital board has helped establish thousands of students in prestigious positions. He not only makes subjects easier for his students but also motivates them with his passion and enthusiasm.

As the Chairman of the scrutiny committee, I am honoured to provide insights into the fundamental objectives of our prestigious award and the rigorous scientific methodologies employed to identify the most deserving candidates.

Objective of the Award:

The primary aim of our Scholar Award program is to recognize and support individuals who exhibit outstanding academic achievements in their respective fields of specializations during graduation and beyond. Furthermore, the final stage of the selection process also involves additional assessment of exemplary leadership qualities and a commitment to community service. We believe in investing in the future by empowering bright minds from our Maheshwari community to pursue their educational aspirations, thereby contributing to the overall development of our community.


Quick snapshot for MVPM 2023 Scholar Award applications:

The last two editions of MVPM Scholar Awards had 139 and 140 applicants respectively. **The current edition** has received a whopping 219 applications, which is a testament to the growing impact and popularity of these awards in our community.

We have also seen a healthy increase in the number of female candidates from our community applying for these awards with the gender ratio Male: Female breaching 60:40 mark this year.

Every year, we reassess the list of disciplines as categories for reference so that there is no bias towards any specific domain and yet we continue to keep up with the times wherein more and more study pathways and career options are available for the youth. Just to highlight this phenomenon, we had an applicant who graduated with majors in humanities from IIT Bombay and an applicant who has a specialised degree in music from a leading school in Valencia, Spain!

Please find below the breakdown of the 219 applications received this year across various disciplines for MVPM Scholar Awards 2023:



Selection Process:

Our commitment to objectivity and fairness is aptly reflected in the meticulous selection process that consists of three broad stages:

- Round 1: Screening | The application is submitted via the official MVPM Scholar website through an
 online form that consists of basic information and details of the academic journey, key milestones and
 achievements. The primary objective at this stage is to check whether the applications meet the eligibility
 criteria such as month and year of graduation, member of Maheshwari community, recognized academic
 degrees etc.
- Round 2: Scrutiny | A detailed application form (to be signed physically by the applicant and their parents; scanned copy for submission) is shared with the eligible candidates and details are requested along with proofs of their degrees, scorecards, accolades etc. Once the detailed application forms with documentation is received (subject to a deadline), they are assessed and rated numerically against the following variables on a pre-defined scale that is normalised with relevant weightages for objective assessment:

Academic Excellence Assessment:

Rigorous scrutiny of academic records, achievements, and performance is conducted to identify candidates with consistently high academic standards. This includes a thorough evaluation of grades, standardized test scores, academic recognition and excellence.

Institution & qualifying degree/ pathway:

The ranking of an institution is a key criteria considered for the profile assessment. The institutions are colleges, universities, and autonomous bodies etc. that award the degrees or a pathway unlocked by meritorious candidates only. We use several yardsticks that are relevant for the different streams to assess the ratings. Eg. For domestic universities we consider the NIRF rankings, for foreign universities we consider

QS Global rankings etc. Pathways such as Civil services and degrees awarded by autonomous bodies such as ICAI are measured on a separate baseline to ensure that there is a level playing field for all applicants.

Holistic Achievement Evaluation:

Beyond academics, we recognize the importance of a well-rounded individual. Candidates are assessed for their involvement in extracurricular activities, leadership roles, and notable accomplishments in areas such as sports, arts, or community service.

 Round 3: Jury | Final round that consists of an eminent jury board that interviews the candidates shortlisted in the Scrutiny round.

As a practice, we always strive to get feedback from the jury panel on selection process and continuously strive to improve the entire process of evaluation and make it as objective as possible.

The scores from the Scrutiny round are considered as a baseline for the final interviews conducted by the Jury board. Additional elements come into play in the final round as follows:

Personal Statements and Interviews:

Applicants are given the opportunity to share their personal journeys, aspirations, and the impact they hope to make on the community. Personal statements and interviews allow the committee to understand the candidates on a deeper level, beyond their academic and extracurricular achievements.

Anonymous Review Process by the Jury:

To eliminate biases, our selection process ensures that the reviewing committee does not have access to the applicants' personal information during the initial stages. This anonymity fosters an objective evaluation based solely on merit and data.

A weighted average of the scores from the scrutiny round and the final interview are usually considered to arrive at the final shortlist of the awardees.

The decision taken by the eminent jury board to identify and award the final list of recipients of MVPM Scholars and Promising Scholars shall always be final & binding.

By adhering to these rigorous and scientific selection methodologies, we strive to maintain the integrity and prestige of our scholar award program. The chosen recipients will not only be scholars but future leaders who embody the values of excellence, leadership, and service.

As we gather to celebrate the accomplishments of our community's brightest minds, let us collectively embrace the spirit of nurturing and empowering the next generation of leaders.

MVPM Maheshwari scholar Award Program

The Genesis

Maheshwari community is considered to be one of the leading business communities in India. Economic contribution of Maheshwaris has been well acknowledged. While being at the forefront of business, industry and trade, Maheshwaris have achieved exceptional feats in educational pursuits too. But business achievements of Maheshvaris are so overwhelming that the community's academic achievements go unnoticed. Having realized this Maheshwari Vidya Pracharak Mandal (MVPM) decided to make its humble contribution towards correcting this perception. As a step in that direction MVPM instituted MVPM's Maheshwari Scholar Awards in 2012 aimed at giving academic recognition to the community which it deserves. The awards recognize extraordinary scholastic achievements of such Maheshwaris who can serve as role models for the youth of our community.

The Award

The MVPM's Maheshwari Scholars are identified from among Maheshwari students all across the globe with outstanding academic records in higher education. They come from very diverse backgrounds like Engineering, Medical, Finance, Management, Law etc. Besides, Ph.Ds& UPSC qualified candidates are also eligible to apply. In selection of awardees there is no fixed number of awards for various educational disciplines. In extreme case all can be from same discipline & none can be from a specific discipline. Neither is any consideration for gender or economic background of applicants. The applicants are evaluated primarily on their scholastic achievements.

In all there are three category of awards, viz. Maheshwari Scholar Award, Promising Maheshwari Scholar Award and Emerging Maheshwari Scholar Award. Each Maheshwari Scholar & Promising Maheshwari Scholar is given a Gold Medal besides Citation. Emerging Maheshwari Scholars are given a citation. In order to recognise any exceptional talent among chosen awardees there is a provision for Outstanding Maheshwari Scholar Award. Besides, a 'Maheshwari Scholar Icon' award in the form of a citation is given to a senior Maheshwari for his/ her scholastic contributions over several years.

The Selection Process

To be eligible for awards one needs to apply in a structured format specified by Scholar Committee. There is also provision for online submission of application forms. There is no provision for nomination in student category. Only candidates who have passed their under-graduate (UG) or Post-graduate (PG) exams or obtained Ph.D or qualified UPSC between 1st October of preceding year & 30th September current year are considered eligible.

From all the applications received, applicants with outstanding scholastic record are shortlisted for a telephonic interview with a jury comprising people who have themselves been scholars and have related achievements to their credit.

On the basis of evaluation by the jury a certain number of awardees are chosen as Maheshwari Scholar, Promising Maheshwari Scholar and Emerging Maheshwari Scholar. Maheshwari Scholar Icon awardee is nominated and chosen by the Managing Committee. There is no provision for application in this category.

The Scholars

The applicants for Scholar awards come from all across the globe including Australia, USA, UK, Germany, Spain & Japan. Within India they come from various states like Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Karnataka Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, and of course Maharashtra.


Over the years Maheshwari Scholar Awards have been scaling newer heights in terms of scholastic achievements. Here is a sample of few achievers. Dr Dinesh Bharadia the recipient of Outstanding Maheshwari Scholar award was included in Forbes list of America's top 30 under 30. Dr Zarana Maheshwari, completed her Ph.D in English Literature with flying colours despite having lost her eyesight. Nishant Totla, the 2012 awardee had received all India rank 2 in IIT – JEE, which is described as world's toughest entrance exam. Another scholar Sanjay Navandhar achieved all India rank 1 in the prestigious CA exam. Laya Maheshwari, one of the awardees went for further studies to Harvard Law School. Darshit Jaju, an IIT – IIM alumnus, was included in The Economic Times top 50 Emerging Leaders of Corporate India.

Eighty four Maheshwaris who received Scholar and Promising Scholar Awards in last seven years include fifteen Ph.Ds from top global universities like Stanford, Cornell, Massachusetts University and INSEAD etc; twenty one engineers from IITs, BITS, Pilani, Georgia Tech, etc;eighteen doctors including super specialists like DM and M.Ch and alumnus of AIIMS, New Delhi;thirteen finance professionals including CA AIR 1, 3 & 5, CS AIR 2 and CMA AIR 8; nine management postgraduates all from IIMs or XLRI; five Public Service Exam qualifiers like IPS, IRS etc; and three from humanities side from top institutions like Cambridge University, London School of Economics, and New York University. The Evolution and Way Ahead

In the first year awardees were chosen from engineering and medicine disciplines. In all five MVPM's Scholar awards were given in the first year. Each award comprised a cash component of Rs 50,000 and a citation. Gradually, over the years, new educational disciplines were added to the award category and now it is free for any discipline of higher education. With increase in the number of applicants from all over the globe, it was decided to not only increase the number of awards to be given each year but also Promising Scholar category was newly created. Later on Outstanding Maheshwari Scholar award category was also created but only as an exception. It has been restricted to only the cream-da-la-cream among the scholars. In last seven years this award has been given once.

The selection process also evolved with experience to include a telephonic interview round. It was realized that all those who get shortlisted for interviews but do not qualify as Scholars or Promising Scholars also deserve to be recognised for their scholastic achievements. As a result a new category of awards, the Emerging Maheshwari Scholar, was added.

A new category of award titled 'Maheshwari Scholar Icon' was instituted in 2018 to honour a senior Maheshwari for his/ her scholastic contributions over several years. The maiden Maheshwari Scholar Icon was presented to Professor (Dr) Rajat Moona, Director, Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Bhilai.

The mission of promoting world class academic excellence in higher education should guide all future decisions and activities related to scholar awards. Completely impartial selection of awardees by independent jury with impeccable academic credentials has been the key to success of scholar awards over the years. More than recognising the talent of outstanding Maheshwari students, the scholar awards have become a platform to showcase world class excellence and inspire the future generations of Maheshwari community. Experience of last seven years shows that almost all scholars are recipients of multiple awards, scholarships and fellowships that too from very reputed organisations and yet Scholar award holds a special place as it comes from the community. It is worth reminding ourselves that 'MVPM's Scholar Award' was rechristened as' MVPM's Maheshwari Scholar Award' to lend that community feeling to the awards. This sanctity has been upheld all through thanks to the generous sponsors who never expected that their names be included as part of the medal, citation or even on banners as presenters of the award. MVPM can take immense satisfaction in the fact that MVPM's Maheshwari Scholar Awards have outgrown and have become a part of entire community's treasure.

On the auspicious day of 6th January 2024, a grand inauguration function unfolded at VN Lahoti Hostel of MVPM (Maheshwari Vidya Pracharak Mandal), Pune, marking a significant milestone in the institution's history. Established in 1962, VN Lahoti Hostel has long been the preferred residence for Maheshwari students pursuing education in Pune. What began with a humble capacity of 60 students underwent phased development over the years, accommodating up to 160 students until recently. The hostel boasted essentials like a small ground, a TV hall, and a mess, but with the changing times and evolving student expectations, the management of MVPM envisioned a comprehensive redevelopment of the entire premises.

Capitalizing on altered government regulations that granted a substantial Floor Space Index (FSI), the management seized the opportunity to not only increase the student capacity but also introduce modern recreational facilities. While the FSI could have allowed for the accommodation of 450-500 students, a paradigm shift in thinking led to the decision to focus on quality over quantity. The capacity was deliberately limited to 313 students, allowing for the creation of a state-of-the-art student hostel.

The additional FSI was ingeniously utilized to incorporate modern amenities, including a 1200 sq.ft. gymnasium equipped with contemporary exercise equipment, a library cum reading rooms capable of hosting 120 students, and a multi-purpose hall with cutting-edge audio-visual equipment and acoustics, accommodating up to 250 students. This versatile hall could be divided into two separate spaces for smaller gatherings. The revamped students' mess, now air-conditioned with improved seating arrangements and a kitchen equipped with ultra-modern facilities, provided a more enjoyable dining experience.

The terrace atop the building, furnished with proper shading, became a versatile space for hosting open functions. One of the major highlights was the introduction of a multi-sports turf ground, utilizing artificial turf for sports like cricket, football, volleyball, badminton, etc., and also serving as a venue for MVPM's public functions accommodating over 500 people.

In addition to these facilities, a dedicated office space for the administrative staff was created alongside a meeting hall, facilitating discussions for volunteers and committee officials. The magnitude of this undertaking would not have been possible without the invaluable support of generous donors.

Generosity flowed as donors rallied behind MVPM's vision. The major contributors and the facilities they sponsored include:

- 1. Tai Karwa Tower: Housing major facilities like the kitchen, dining hall, and multi-purpose hall, this tower is Sponsored by Shri Shrikantji Karwa and Karwa family, of Catapharma Ltd, Nashik






Today we have total 8 hostels in Pune and 2 hostels in Mumbai. Over 1000 boys and girl students are availing this facility.

In the last 10 years, MVPM has more than doubled its hostel intake capacity. From 488 in the year 2012 now it is 1029 seats in 2022. With completion of Airoli Girls Hostel, Redevelopment of LL Mundada Hostel and addition of two towers at VN Lahoti Hostel, the total capacity will cross 1500 seats.




